

CONFIGURING ISLAND WITH AT&T MODEM/ROUTER GATEWAY


If you have AT&T services, you are required to use the gateway combo equipment supplied to you. To use Island as your router, you must do three things:

- Install the Island app (see QR code)
- Install a separate Wi-Fi access point or mesh (you will disable the built in Wi-Fi in the gateway)
- Put the AT&T gateway in IP Passthrough mode after installation (see page 2)


Step 1: Disconnect any existing switch or mesh Wi-Fi system from the gateway.




Step 2: Connect Island to power Allow about 30 seconds for Island to boot up, until the light turns from white to solid blue.



Step 3: Connect one of the Island ports to the AT&T gateway.



Step 4: Connect any new or existing switch and/or Wi-Fi mesh to another port on the Island.



Step 5: If using a Wi-Fi mesh system, place it into Access Point (AP) mode using the manufacturer's instructions. For a list of common AP's and meshes, see our <u>resources</u> <u>page</u>.

Step 6: Use the Island app to connect to the Island.



Now let's put the AT&T gateway into passthrough mode.


Putting the AT&T Gateway in Passthrough Mode after Installing Island.


Step 1:

Open a browser and enter the IP address of the gateway located on the label (e.g., 192.168.1.254). Log in to the webbased set up page using the Access Code found on the label of the gateway.

Step 2:

Select Firewall and then IP Passthrough.





Step 3:

On the Allocation Mode, select Passthrough from the drop-down menu:

Step 4:

Select **DHCPS-fixed** from the drop-down menu in **Passthrough Mode**. Then, on the Manual Entry section, enter the **MAC address of Island**, which you plugged in to the AT&T gateway. Click the **Save** button to complete the setup.

 $\underline{\text{Note}} :$ You can find the MAC address (it's the number that begins with **08008A**) one of three ways:

- In the app under the network menu (make sure you're in Geek mode to see the MAC address)
- In the pull-down menu on the AT&T Passthrough Fixed MAC Address field
